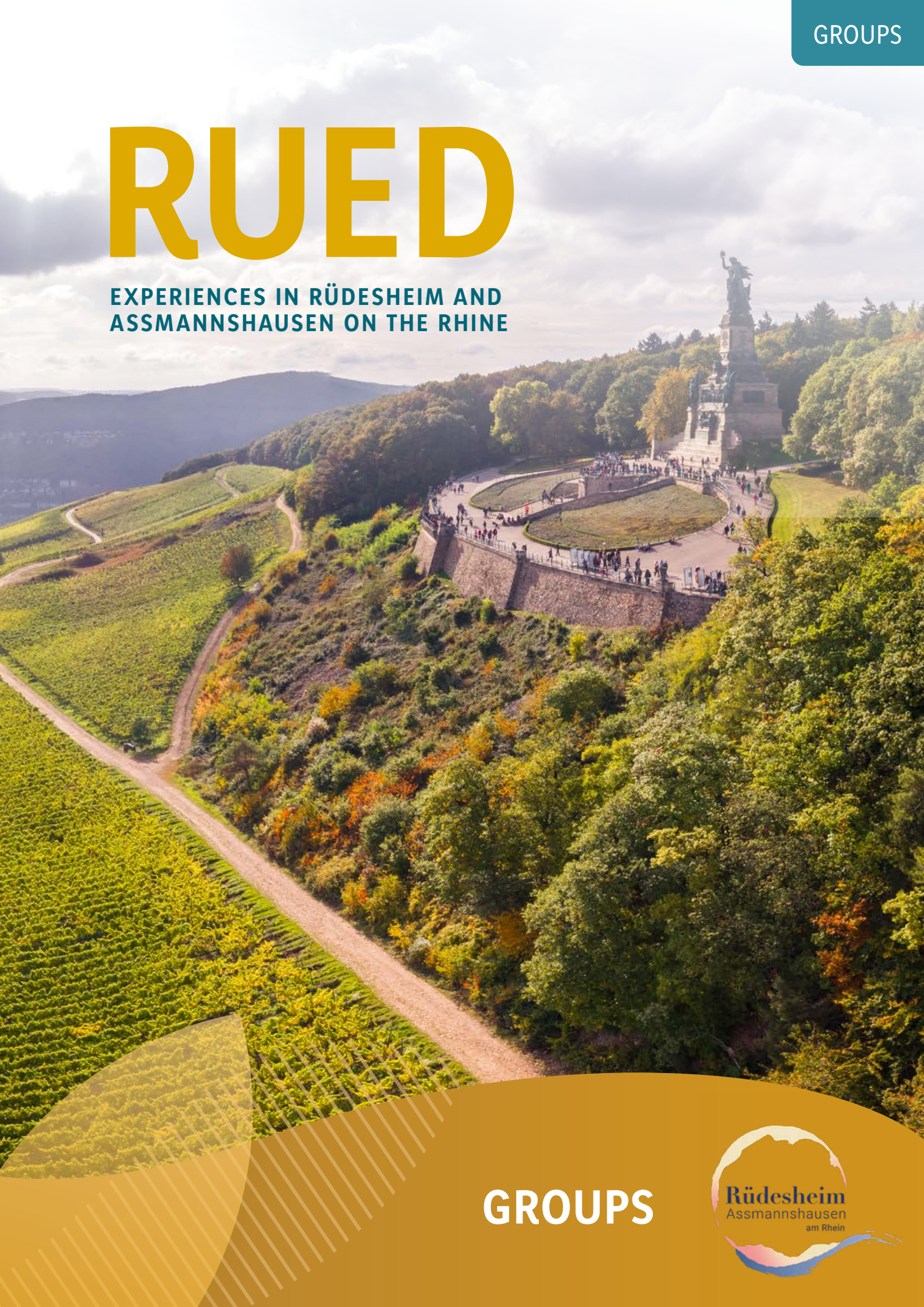

Brömserburg

Brömserburg Castle is just a few hundred metres from the world-famous Drosselgasse. The castle has been as much a part of Rüdesheim as the Rhine and the vines for around 1,000 years. It sits enthroned with a breathtaking view of the Rhine and the romantic Middle Rhine Valley. Many people have been enchanted by its charm in the past. It holds many treasures for visitors, both large and small, just waiting to be discovered on a journey through the past. Our expert guided tour of the medieval castle lasts around 45 minutes and ends with an included glass of sparkling wine in the beautifully landscaped, cosy castle garden.

From here, the route leads via the pilgrimage church of Eibingen back to the historic old town of Rudesheim. During the tour, 2 mulled wines are sampled.

It continues through the beautiful vineyards to the Benedictine Abbey of St Hildegard. Many viewpoints provide insights into Hildegard's life and the landscape of her time.

Rüdesheim and Bingen

A journey that brings the concept of Rhine Romanticism to life on the Rhine. The boat takes you to Bingen, to the Museum am Strom and on to the Rhein-Nahe-Eck, a well-known motif for Rhine fans. Back in Rüdesheim, the tour continues with the texts of the famous Romantic poets to the old town and from there by cable car to the Tempel am Niederwald. This tour ends in the beautiful old town with a glass of wine and a pretzel.

4. Rupertsberg vault and Hildegard Memorial Church (Bingerbrück)

The Roman Catholic parish church of St Rupertus and St Hildegard (also known as the Hildegard Memorial Church) is a listed church building in the neo-Romanesque style in Bingerbrück, a district of Bingen am Rhein.

5. Lunch break/lunch at the Hildegard Forum – Visit to Rochus Chapel

The lunch break at the Hildegard Forum also includes a visit to St Rochus Chapel. From the grounds of this pilgrimage church built at the end of the 19th century on the Rochusberg in Bingen, the view of the UNESCO World Heritage Upper Middle Rhine Valley is fascinating.

6. Monastery ruins Disibodenberg – (Odernheim a. d. Glan)

Disibodenberg can be seen from afar at the confluence of the Glan and Nahe rivers. This popular excursion destination is home to the ruins of a monastery. On 1 November 1112, three young women, including fourteen-year-old Hildegard, were admitted to the monastery in a new women's hermitage founded for them. In 1998, to celebrate the 900th birthday of Hildegard of Bingen, a museum was opened on the hillside and the newly built Hildegard Chapel was consecrated.

Eberbach Monastery

(Programme on site, no bus escort from Rudesheim)

One of the most famous sights in the Rheingau is the former Cistercian abbey of Eberbach. With its romantic and early Gothic buildings, it is one of the most important artistic monuments in Europe. Founded in 1136, the abbey existed until its dissolution in 1803. There is an extensive range of different guided tours in the abbey complex, which can be booked through us. All guided tours always begin with a tour of the monastery and can be complemented by a wine tasting from the Hessian state wineries. We will be happy to inform you about the possibilities.

Siegfried's Mechanical Music Cabinet

The first museum for mechanical musical instruments in Germany. One of the largest collections of self-playing musical instruments is presented here. You can see the history of the development of the cultural asset "mechanical music". How these instruments make music is a unique experience.

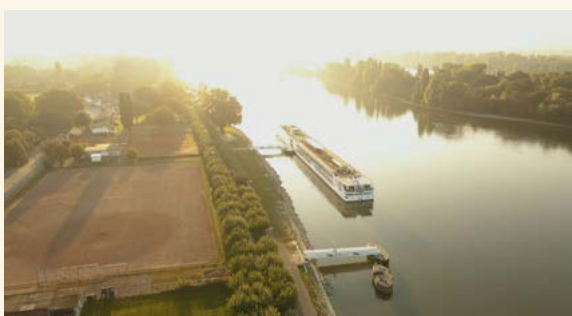

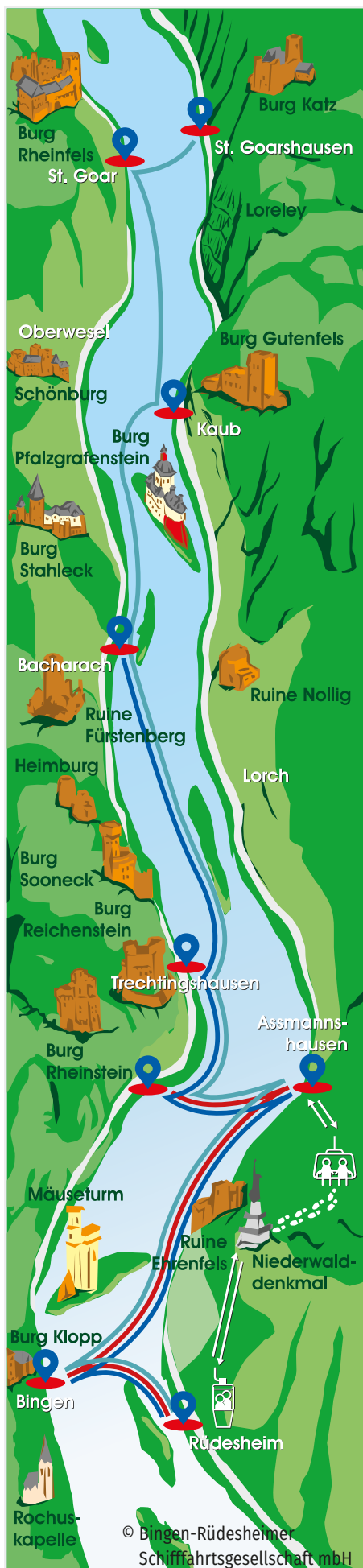
